The award is given annually, and the judging criteria is based on accomplishments during the **previous year, January 1 to December 31**. This award is first judged on the District level.

### Rules for Participation

1. Three (3) copies of the entry must be sent by the club president to the District President, unless otherwise directed, postmarked no later than **February 1**. Entry may not exceed four pages (one being the cover).
2. The District President or District Awards Chairman will have these judged, and the district award will be made at the District Arts Festival. Following the District Arts Meeting, three (3) copies of the district winning award entry will be sent to the Public Issues Community Service Program Chairman postmarked no later than **March 1st**. 3. Three judges are selected for both the District and State awards, with a least one of them being a clubwoman.
4. Past winners of this award on the State level shall not be eligible to win the same award again.
5. A club may not enter the same member for more than one of the GFWC-NC Individual Awards. Clubs may, however, enter different members in all of the appropriate categories. Previous winners of this award on the state level are ineligible to win again.

### Criteria:

Judging criteria will be based on activities for **the previous calendar year only**. Submit in detail the achievements and the nature of service of your candidate, noting the qualifications of your nominee and keeping in mind that the judging will be based on the following items:

- Outstanding contributions in citizenship, patriotism, and community affairs include church, political, other service organizations, civic, board positions, etc. ....75 Points
- Contribution through Federation: 5-State, 5-District, 5-Local ..... 15 Points
- Cooperation with individuals .....10 Points
- TOTAL ..... 100 Points
