General Clubwoman of the Year Award - *Minnie Lou Parker Creech Wine Cooler*, Minnie Lou Parker Creech, donor. The award is given annually to honor a clubwoman who has given of her time, talents, interest, organizational efforts, and active participation to render outstanding service through the Federation. The judging criteria is based on accomplishments during **the previous year, January 1 to December 31**. This award is first judged on the District level.

Rules for Participation

1. Three copies of the entry must be sent by the club president to the District President or District Awards Chairman postmarked no later than **February 1** of each year. Entry may not exceed four pages (one being the cover).
2. The District President or District Awards Chairman will have these judged by three competent clubwomen who live outside and preferably not adjacent to the district for which they serve as judges. The district award will be presented at the District Arts Festival.
3. Following the District Arts meeting, three (3) copies of the district winning award entry will be sent to State Second Vice President postmarked no later than **March 1st**. 4. The three judges for selection of the state winner should be those serving as past presidents of other state organizations in North Carolina and/or Past Presidents or Directors of Juniors of GFWC-NC or of other states in the GFWC; with a least one being a member of the GFWC-NC.
5. The judging is based on the criteria listed on the appropriate form.
6. Past winners of this award on the State level shall not be eligible to win the same award again.
7. A club may not enter the same member for more than one of the GFWC-NC Individual Awards. Clubs may, however, enter different members in all of the appropriate categories. Previous winners of this award on the state level are ineligible to win again.

Criteria:

Judging criteria will be based on activities for the previous calendar year only. The award is given annually to honor a clubwoman who has given of her time, talents, interest, organizational efforts and active participation to render outstanding service. Submit in detail the achievements and the nature of service of your candidate, noting the qualifications of your nominee and keeping in mind that the judging will be based on the following items:

- Contribution through Federation: 30-State, 25-District, 25-Local..... 80 Points
- Participation in Community Affairs (Church, political, other service organizations, civic, board positions, etc.10 Points
- Cooperation with individuals and other club members10 Points
- TOTAL 100 Points

Note: Nominees will be judged only on the information you furnish.
