Junior “Magic” Clubwoman Award

Kim Pfeil Pearce Oak Leaf Bowl, Kim Pfeil Pearce, donor. This award is to be given annually to a Junior clubwoman who by her efforts provides the “magic” for her club. It is not to be given on the basis of community or club involvement, but rather awarded to that person who best exemplifies the words of the *Collect for Clubwomen*.

Rules for Participation

1. The nominee shall not be entered for any other state individual award and can be submitted by any Junior club.
2. This entry is judged only on the State level. 3. This entry of no more than three pages double-spaced, including the cover sheet, shall be judged by the Junior Officers.
4. Past winners of this award on the State level shall not be eligible to win the same award again.
5. A club may not enter the same member for more than one of the GFWC-NC Individual Awards. Clubs may, however, enter different members in all of the appropriate categories. Previous winners of this award on the state level are ineligible to win again.

Criteria

Judging will be based on the following criteria:

- This clubwoman may be the silent backbone of her club, the leader who has turned it all around, or the person who doggedly would not let the club fold. She might be a clubwoman who, though she has many obligations, is still always faithful to her club. She may have not missed a meeting or may have brought in five new members with her enthusiasm. She might just have offered a smile and added the laughter over the years that has made club work more enjoyable through her magical touch.
